What was the clue that "gave it away" for you or for the character? The

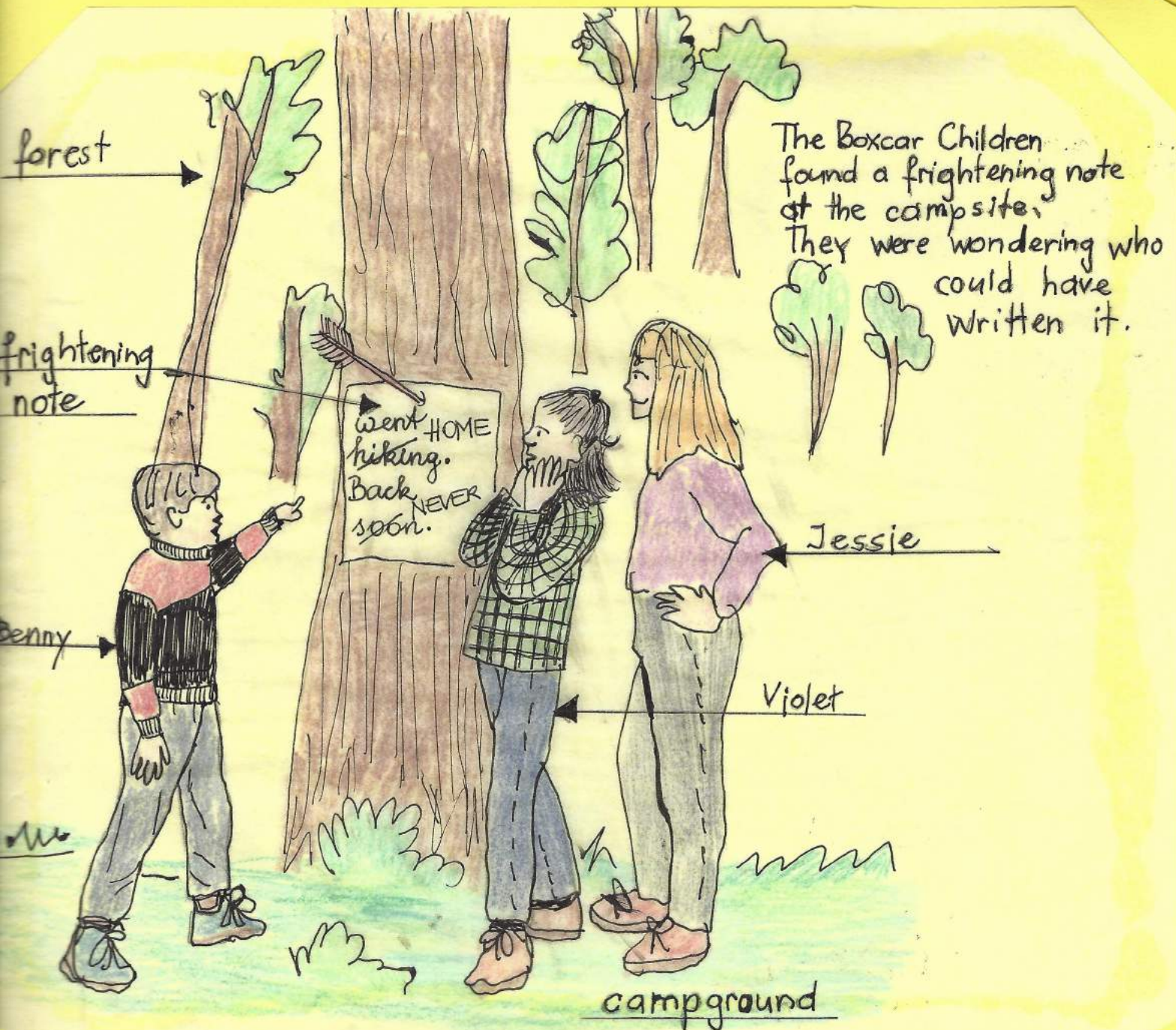
clue for the character was the sound coming out of Andy's cabin.
