gym hall

ACTIVITIES

running, hitting the ball, scoring a goal, training with the ball, aiming the ball

EQUIPMENT

sports shoes, floorball stick, plastic ball with holes, glasses for protection

POSITIVE SIDES

team sport; good for making friends; lots of fun; lots of moving; indoor game: can be played at any weather

FEELINGS

exciting, exhausting, good fun

exciting, exhausting, good fun
