INTRODUCTION

Many young EFL learners appear to lack the skills and/or the motivation to expand their vocabulary range and their communicative language skills effectively.

The reasons could be:

- lack of natural exposure to the target language
- o no immediate need
- lack of connection to real life
- o different approaches towards learning (21st century)
